

## Fellow traveller, **HEALTH COMES FIRST.**



The Peruvian Government has taken these measures to combat COVID-19:

- As part of the **economic revival**, international flights have resumed for some countries in the Americas and Europe. Likewise, protocols have been approved for hotels and restaurants, as well as for train service for passengers, travel agencies, guides and hostels and for adventure tourism, among others.
- Foreign travellers can arrive in Peru only with their **molecular test (PCR)** indicating that they do not have coronavirus, without the need to comply with quarantine upon arrival. The results of these tests must be obtained at least 72 hours before the check-in. In addition, an affidavit must be completed by clicking [here](#).
- The **reopening of land borders** is authorised, for which the respective Regional Government must adopt relevant biosecurity measures in coordination with the Ministry of Health.
- The **use of masks** to circulate throughout the country is mandatory, and to maintain the decrease in contagion, the population is reminded of constant hand washing and maintaining social distance.
- The State of National Emergency will remain in effect until **7 March 2021**, as well as the free circulation of people from 04:00 to 00:00 hours.
